

Study visa

All persons who plan to study at a college or university are required to obtain a residence permit in form of the study visa.

A study visa is a national (German) visa so it allows you to enter the other Schengen countries for a stay up to 90 days as a tourist.

As soon as the application with the required documents is complete, it will be forwarded to the local foreigners' office in Germany.

After approval of the application, the German Embassy issues a residence permit in the form of a visa for the first 90 days. A final residence permit is issued in Germany by the Foreigners Authority. Therefore, <u>all</u> holders of residence permits must register upon their first arrival.
